Dear Colleagues,

The monsoon issue of our newsletter is before you.

Hope you are well along with your family. I had written to you last year (July 2004 Newsletter) and had informed in detail about the landmark hon'ble supreme court judgment. True to our apprehensions, the media propagated that following this judgment doctors would go scot free and harm the patient. What they do not understand is that no doctor wants to harm his patient, not even by act of omission. Furthermore, the hon'ble court has only pronounced that mishaps during surgery should not always be construed as criminal offences. The judgment of the hon'ble supreme court was challenged in a revision petition. The learned bench, has virtually upheld the earlier judgment.

I have brought an update on this judgment, since it puts more responsibility on us. We should take extra precautions, communicate well with the patient and his family, inform them clearly of the possible complications, give realistic expectations and treat our patient with sincerity and empathy. Only then the rising trend of litigations can be reversed.

We also have the experience of holding many international conferences including the IPRAS 1987. I would like that our members agree and give positive feedback. We may then make a bid to host the 15th International IPRAS conference for 2011.

Our prestigious Peet Prize (my friends jestfully call it ^ekj&ihV* Prize) is often in news. Last year too, it found its echo in the postmortem discussions of APSICON-2004. Yahoo is a group which is international, and putting association matters on this forum is inappropriate. It may be discussed by

our esteemed members within the association or during meetings. Hence, I too refrained from replying. I am not trying to protect anyone, but may I clarify, as for the selection of judges is concerned, the judges (for all awards) are appointed for 3 years, and much in advance. The president/secretary or any other office bearer for that year has no say. The judges for 2004-2006 term were nominated in the general body meeting of APSICON-2002 and already printed in the newsletter of December, 2002.

Individuals may differ in their opinion from the collective opinion of judges. The technical aspects also are taken in consideration while judging like, quality of slides, finishing in the allotted time, whether the work is original, has it been published / presented earlier, has the place of work been mentioned (in APSI best paper – the place of work is not to be mentioned), etc.

I am happy to inform that due to the persistent efforts and perseverance of Dr. J.R. Jaju, the 80G exemption has been extended upto 31.03.08 vide letter no. vfl-fu-@Nw-@ey@80-th-@2005@2005&06 dated 25-06-05. Donations to the association are exempt under section 80G of the I.T. act. Please encourage donations, and avail of this benefit. I on the behalf of the association, and on my own behalf thank Dr. J.R. Jaju, Executive Trustee for his valuable efforts. Another long pending matter which requires urgent attention pertains to registration of amendments to our constitution.
